


Construction Hot Topics

Week of December 14, 2020

1. Terminal 1.5: Departures Level Sidewalk

- The permanent Departures Level sidewalk at Terminal 1.5 has been re-opened for pedestrian use
- This week, work will continue nightly to demolish the temporary pedestrian sidewalk that has been in place since January 2019 to facilitate work on the Terminal 1.5 Development Program




Terminal 1.5 permanent Departures Level sidewalk re-opened after being closed for nearly two years

2. LAX Holiday Moratorium

- The LAX Christmas / New Year Holiday Construction Moratorium will go into effect this Friday, December 18, 2020 at 6AM and run through Monday, January 4, 2021 at 9PM
- The moratorium will be in place to limit construction-related shutdowns, allowing for critical public-use areas, traffic lanes and utilities to remain available to guests during peak holiday travel periods

3. Terminal 2 /3: Construction Progress

- Construction continues on the Delta Sky Way Program to renovate and modernize Terminals 2 and 3, including the “Terminal 2 / 3 Head House” which will connect the two terminals and provide access to the Automated People Mover’s future Center Station
