

1. Terminal 2.5: Automated People Mover Pedestrian Bridge


- To facilitate the construction of the APM Pedestrian Bridge at Terminal 2.5, full closures of Arrivals Level Outer Lanes and Departures Level Lanes will occur during limited overnight hours this week as structural components of the bridge are installed
- During all closures, traffic will be detoured with signage and flaggers in place
- Please use caution when driving through construction areas



Terminal 2.5 APM Pedestrian Bridge:


(Left) Arrivals Outer Lane Full Closure Detour Configuration



2. Terminal 5.5: Construction Progress

- The Terminal 5.5 Core project has completed installation of exterior glass panels
- While additional work is still ongoing, this marks a major milestone for the building which will, upon completion, provide enhanced connectivity between Terminals 5 and 6
- As construction continues, drop-off and pick-up lanes on the Arrivals and Departures Levels are being used as temporary pedestrian walkways; traffic is maintained at all times




*Terminal 5.5 Progress from




3. Parking Structure 2B: September Impacts


- This week, Parking Structure 2B will experience the following ingress impacts through Friday, September 24
 - Arrivals Entrance: Closed nightly (12AM to 6AM)
 - Departures Entrance: Closed 24/7
- Signage will be posted; Alternative parking options include Park One, Parking Structure 2A or Parking Structure 3


