



SOUTHBOUND I-405 RAMP IMPACTS

- TO FACILITATE WORK FOR THE LANDSIDE ACCESS MODERNIZATION PROGRAM, INTERMITTENT NIGHTLY CLOSURES OF SOUTHBOUND I-405 RAMPS AT CENTURY BOULEVARD (WEST & EAST) WILL BE TAKEN ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS THROUGH FRIDAY, JULY 21, 2023
- WORK WILL OCCUR BETWEEN 11PM AND 6AM
- WHEN RAMPS ARE CLOSED, ADVANCED SIGNAGE WILL BE IN PLACE TO NOTIFY MOTORISTS
- DETOUR SIGNAGE WILL BE IN PLACE TO FACILITATE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

Travelers using SB I-405 to reach LAX may experience delays when closures are in place; Please watch for posted signage and use caution when traveling near construction areas





TRAFFIC MAINTAINED:


On nights when this closure is implemented, detour signage will be in place and traffic will be maintained at all times
