LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LAX)  
TEMPORARY NORTH COMPLEX RUNWAY 24L/6R CLOSURES  
December 8<sup>th</sup>- 9<sup>th</sup> and December 12<sup>th</sup>- 15<sup>th</sup>

LAX will temporarily close the north inboard runway 24L/6R this Thursday and Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, and next week Monday through Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 for approximately 5 hours from 1 AM to 6 AM each night. These runway closures are necessary to facilitate environmental work near the runway area.

Persons living near LAX may notice a change in aircraft flight activity and noise during these temporary runway closures. When the north inboard runway (24L/6R) temporarily closes during these periods, more aircraft are expected to use the north outboard runway (24R/6L) for departure and arrival operations. In addition, some aircraft operations are expected to shift from the north to the south runway complex. The FAA will continue to conduct [Over-Ocean Operations](#) at LAX during these closures between midnight and 6:30 A.M. if weather and other operational conditions permit.
