LOS ANGELES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (LAX)
DEVIATION FROM OVER-OCEAN OPERATIONS
September 1 - 8, 2017
12 AM – 6:30 AM

LAX will temporarily deviate from Over-Ocean Operations for eight nights (12 AM – 6:30 AM) starting Friday, September 1st through Friday, September 8th, due to the closure of Taxiway A and South Outboard Runway 25L/7R for asphalt repaving and maintenance, respectively.

Whenever possible, the FAA transitions [LAX air traffic flow](#) to Over-Ocean Operations from 12 AM to 6:30 AM, wherein aircraft arrive and depart over the ocean to minimize noise disturbance to the communities directly east of the airport. During this traffic flow, the south runway complex is utilized primarily for departures while the north runway complex is utilized primarily for arrivals.

The closure of Taxiway A and/or Runway 25L/7R requires Design Group VI aircraft (A380 and B747-800) to depart on Runway 24L/6R on the north complex, which would conflict with aircraft arrivals on the same runway complex during Over-Ocean Operations. Therefore, the FAA plans to deviate temporarily from this traffic flow and maintain air traffic in Westerly Operations during these eight nights. As a result, persons living near the airport may notice a change in aircraft flight activity and noise.
