Terminal B APM Pedestrian Bridge Construction

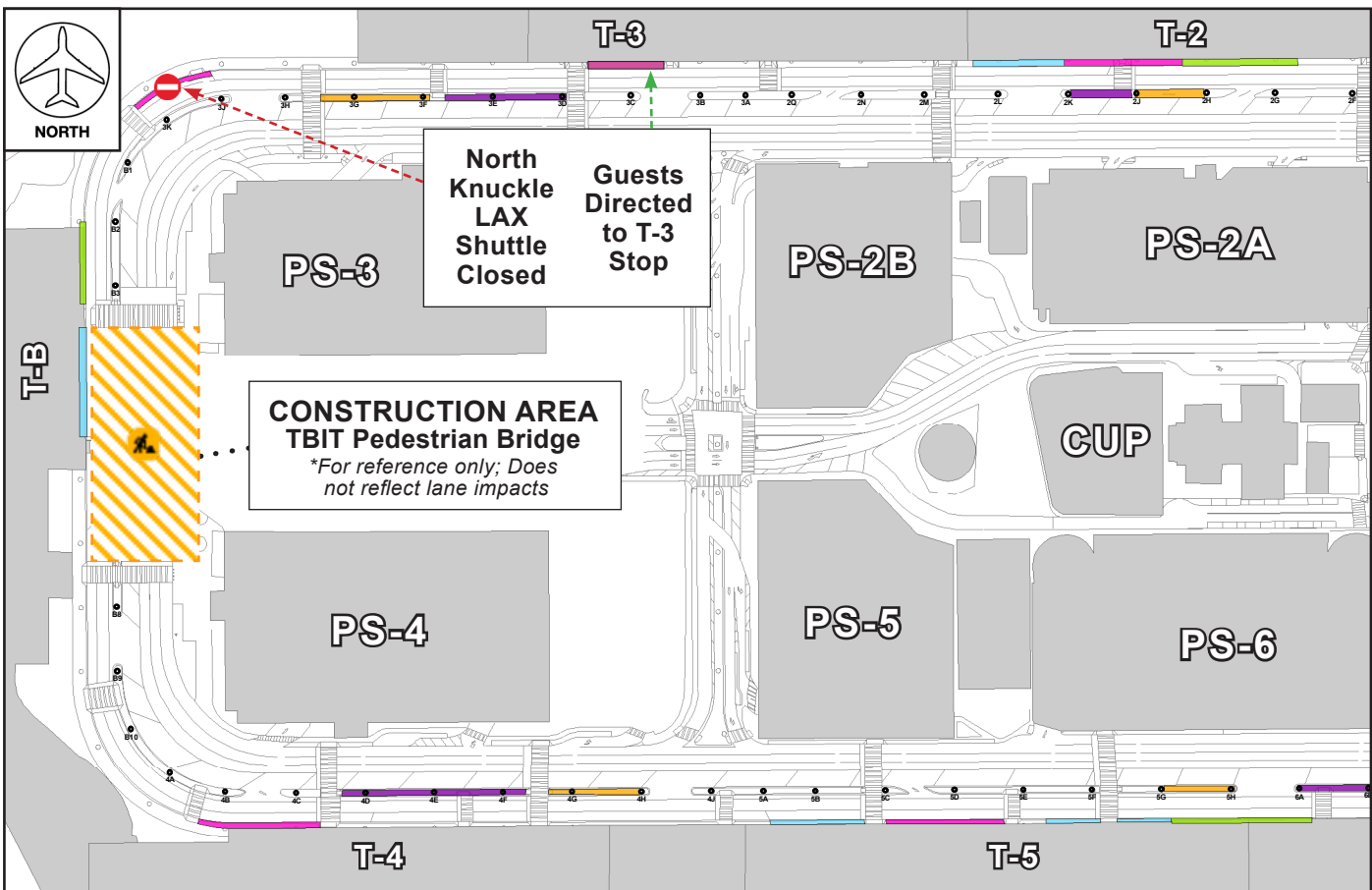
The Automated People Mover project will construct a Pedestrian Bridge over the roadways at Terminal B to connect the terminal to the West CTA Station.

To facilitate this work, the LAX Shuttle Stop (pink) at the Arrivals Level North Knuckle (area between Terminal 3 and Terminal B) will be closed 24/7 starting Sunday, September 11 at 7AM through Saturday, October 22 at 6AM. The LAX Shuttle Stop services the Terminal Connector, LAX City Bus Center, LAX Economy Parking, Metro Connector and LAX Employee Lot shuttles.

Guests will be directed to the next available stop at Terminal 3. Signage will be in place to assist with wayfinding.

Additional notifications will be issued with more details on the APM Pedestrian Bridge installation. Please watch for signage and prepare to follow detour routes. Use caution when traveling near construction areas.
