



TAXILANE D8 CLOSURE

Taxilane D8 between Terminals 1 and 2 will be closed for repaving from 0001L on October 30, 2019 to 2359L on November 2, 2019. The purpose of the work is to repair the deteriorating asphalt in the D8 taxilane.

This closure impacts Terminal 1 and Terminal 2: Southwest Airlines, Delta Airlines and Terminal 2 Airlines

Terminal 1 Gate Closures and Modifications:

- Closed – Gates 12A, 14, 16,
- Impacted – Gate 18A will remain open with a modified lead-in line and will be restricted to aircraft tow in only.

Terminal 2 Gate Closures :

- Closed – Gates 21A, 21B, 23A, 23 and 25

Aer Lingus will be accommodated at the West Remote Gates and will be supported by LAWA Bus Operations.

A Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) will be issued 72 hours prior to the scheduled closure. Please plan your flight operations accordingly. For current airfield operating conditions please check NOTAMs at <https://pilotweb.nas.faa.gov>. Thank you for your support.
