Subject: Change to the LAX Rules and Regulations, mandating the wearing of face coverings

Due to the worldwide health crisis of COVID-19, effective September 15, 2020 the LAWA Rules and Regulations will be updated to include section 3.5.12, requiring all badge holders to wear face covering while on airport property.

3.5.12 – When there is a City, County, or State mandate in effect requiring face coverings in public areas due to a health crisis, all LAX badge holders must wear a face covering while on airport property and when there is, or can be, contact with other employees or the public

This mandate follows the City of Los Angeles Mayors directive that, requiring Angelinos to wear face coverings when they leave their homes and will be near other people. More information can be found at <https://corona-virus.la/FaceCovering>.

This new rule will be enforced by Airport Operations and Airport Police and administered through the SAFE Program.
