1. Terminal 5: New Arrivals Level Restrooms

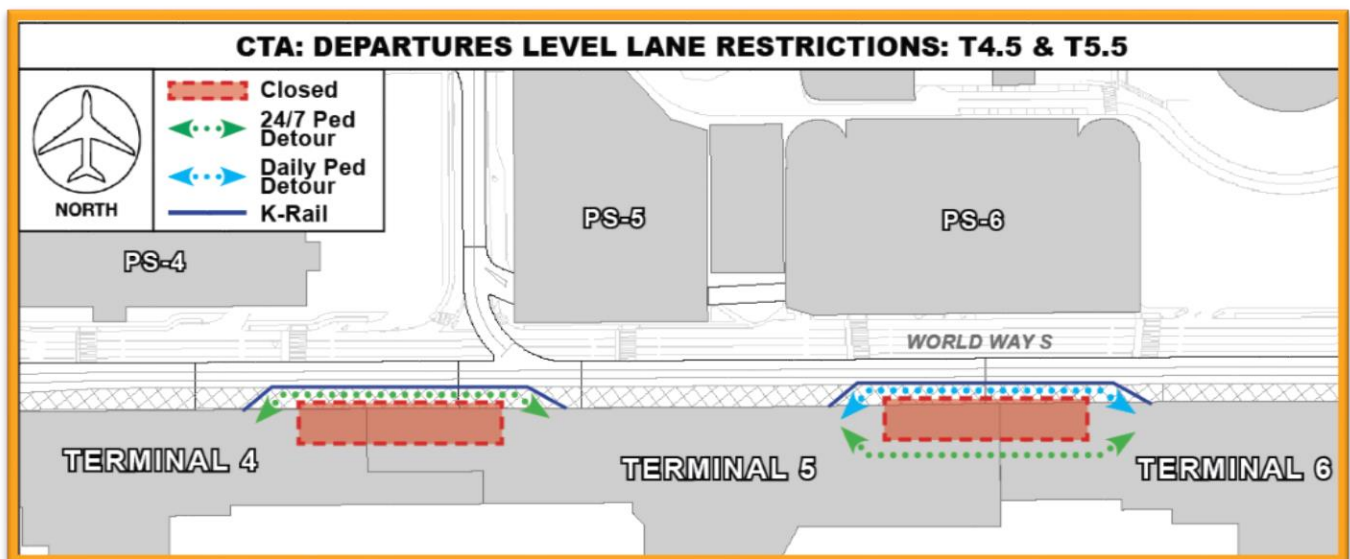
- New restrooms on the Arrivals Level in Terminal 5 are scheduled to open this week as part of the American Airlines T4/5 Modernization Program
- The new restrooms are in Baggage Claim near Claim Device #4

2. CTA Departures Level: Canopy Demolitions

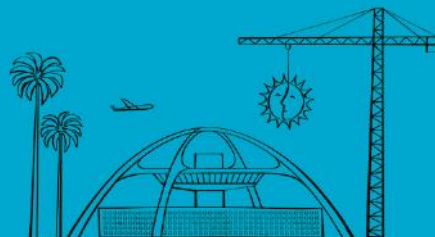
- The overhead canopy on the Departures Levels is currently being demolished between Terminals 4 & 5 (T4.5) and Terminals 5 & 6 (T5.5)
- At T4.5 the sidewalk and both drop off lanes are closed through October 29, 2019 with pedestrians detoured outside at all times
- At T5.5 the sidewalk and both drop off lanes are closed through November 14, 2019 with pedestrians detoured either inside the terminal or outside daily and inside the terminal nightly
- Traffic and passenger drop off is maintained at all times

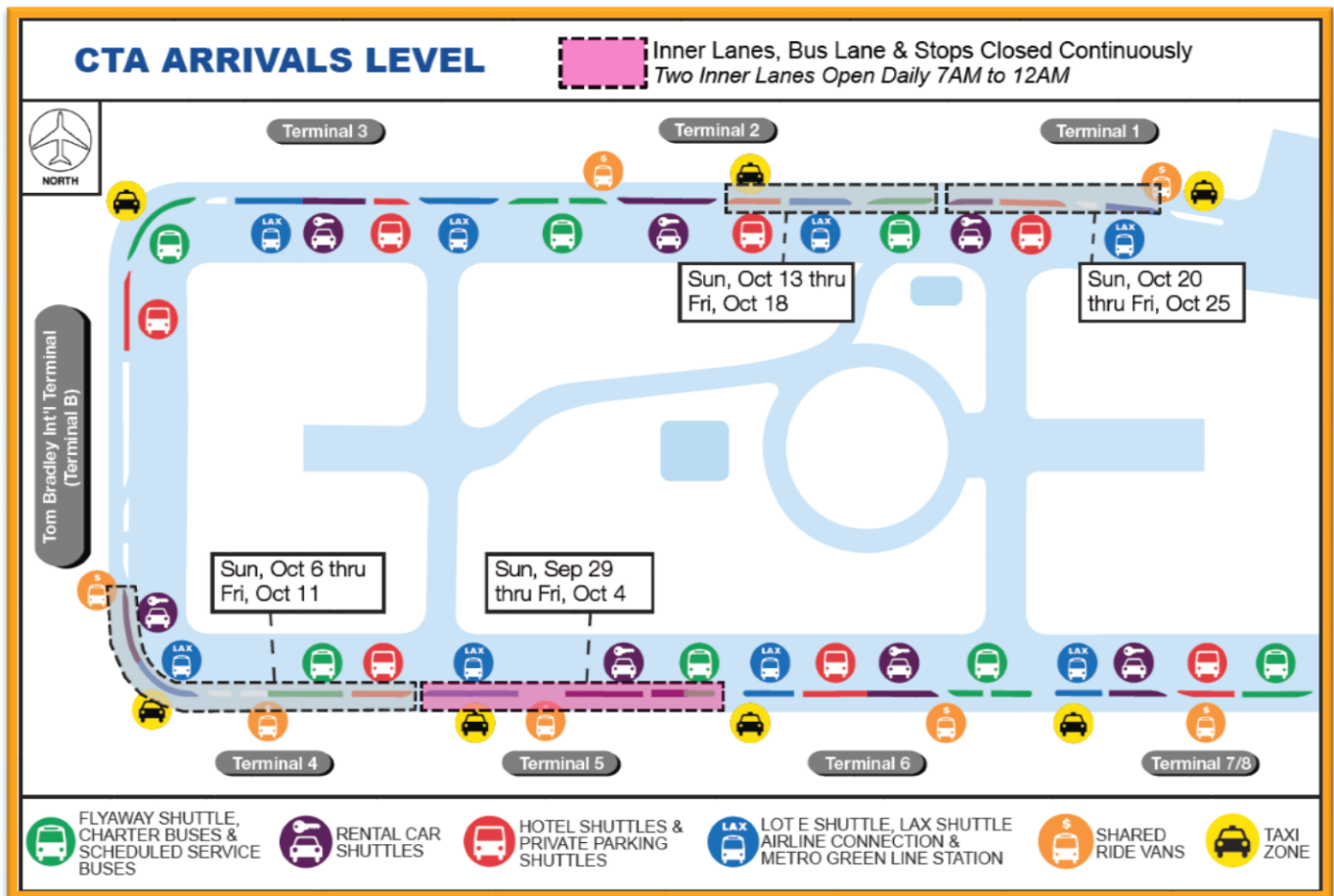

3. [UPDATE] CTA Arrivals Level: Curb Extension

- The Interim Ground Access project will restrict portions of the Arrivals Level Inner Lanes, Bus Lane and shuttle stops through Friday, October 25 to widen the curb at the shuttle stop islands
- Work this week will be performed at Terminal 5
- Traffic is maintained and signage will be posted guiding pedestrians to the next available shuttle stop as necessary
