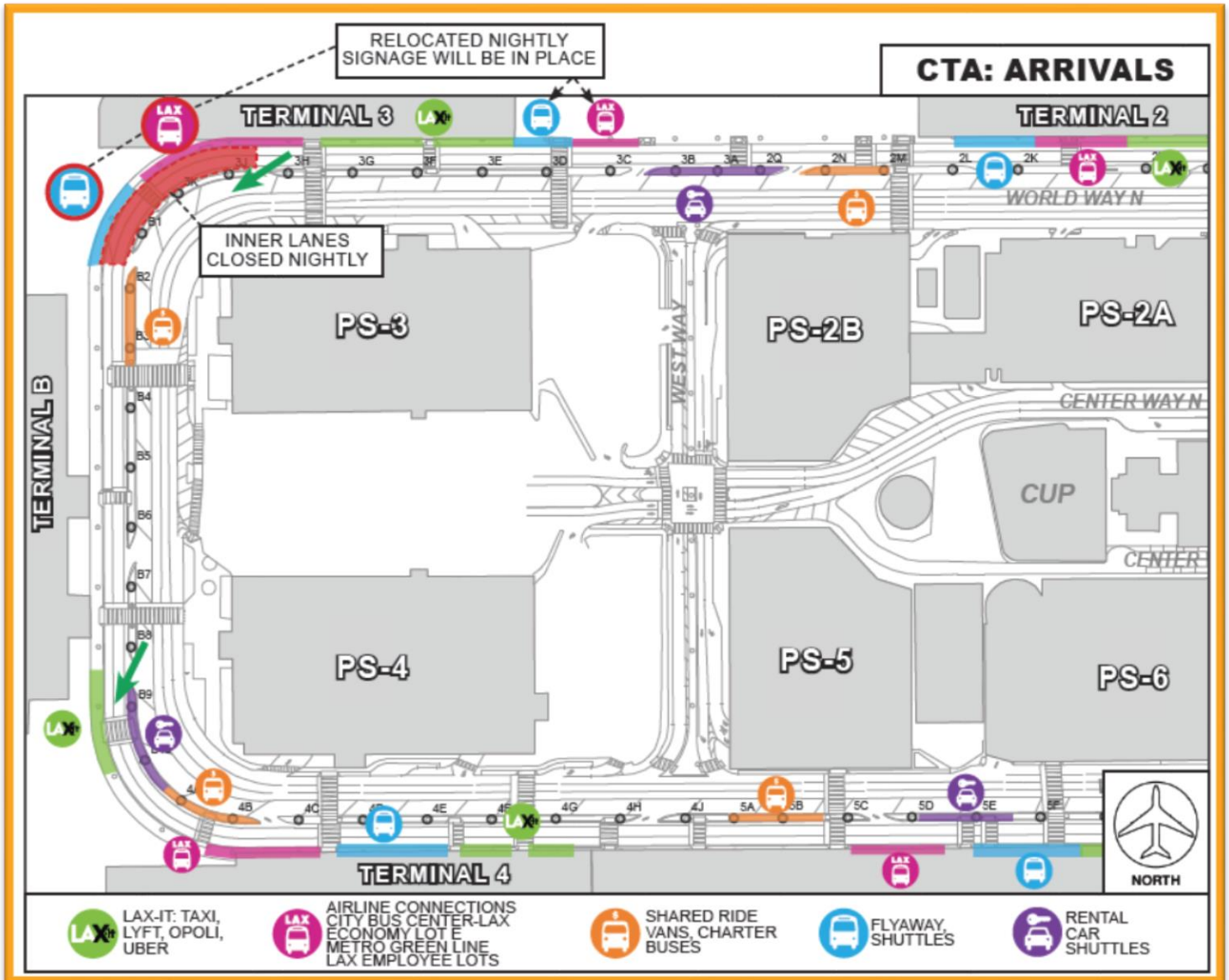


# Construction Hot Topics

## 1. Terminal 3 / B: Nightly Lane Restrictions

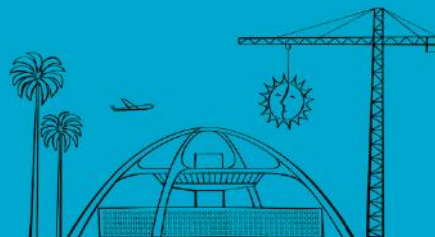
- Construction for the future Terminal B (Tom Bradley International) APM Core will close all inner lanes between Terminal 3 and Terminal B nightly (1AM to 6AM) through June 20, 2020
- Ground transportation stops at this area will be relocated nightly during the closures; signage will be posted and traffic will be maintained at all times

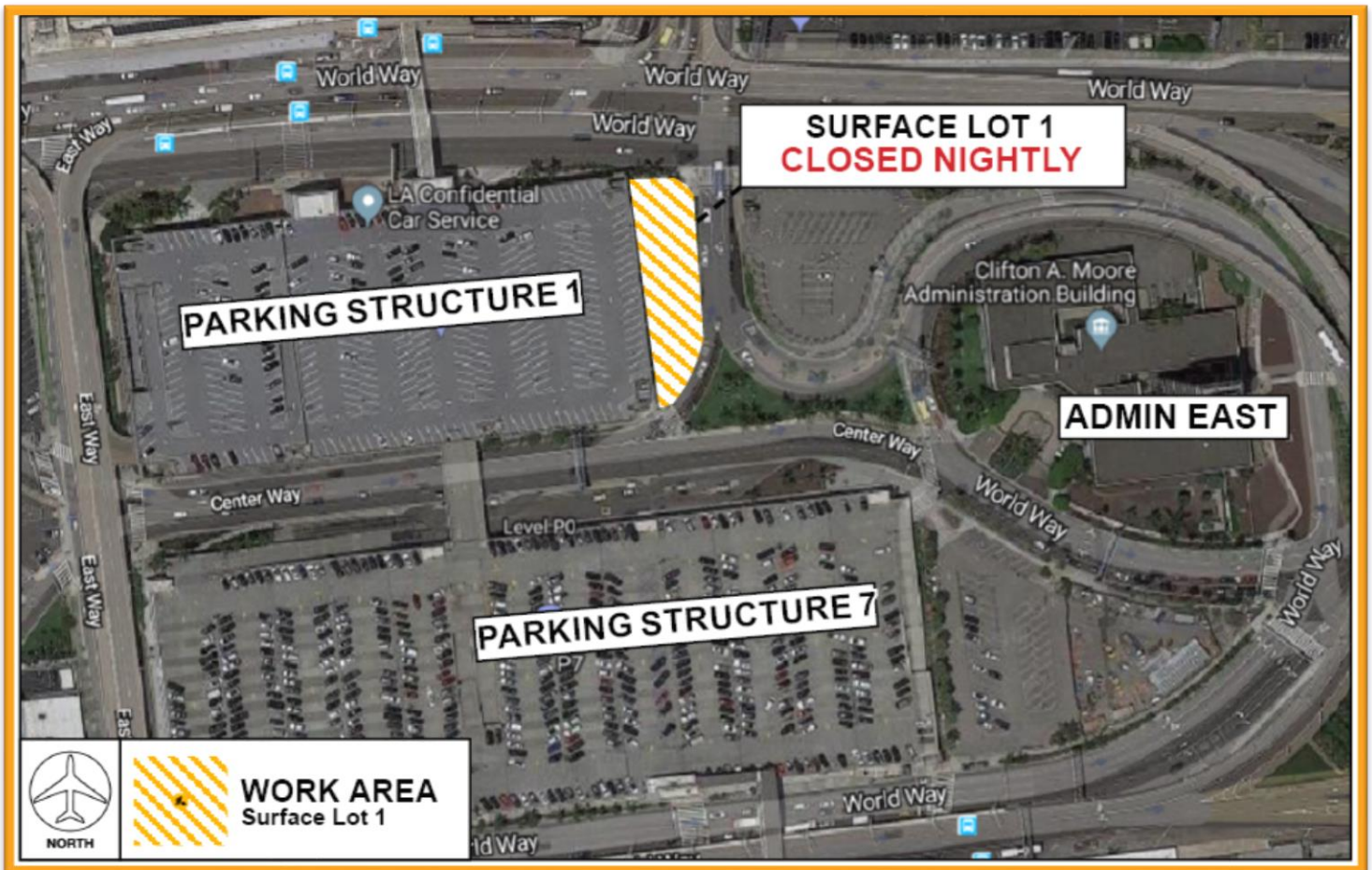

## 2. Surface Lot 1: Nightly Parking Restrictions

- Automated People Mover construction will close Surface Lot 1 nightly through Wednesday, March 25, 2020
- No parking (including EV Charging stalls) will be in effect Monday through Friday only from 10PM to 7AM
- Parking Structure 1 is not impacted by this work and will remain available parking
- Passengers are encouraged to use [FlyLAX.com](http://FlyLAX.com) to check real-time parking structure availability

### 3. Terminal 1.5 Construction Progress

- Construction continues airside on “Terminal 1.5” – the connector building between Terminals 1 and 2 that will provide additional passenger ticking and baggage check-in areas, increased security screening, a secure passenger connection between the two terminals, and more

### 4. Terminal 2: Hotel Private Parking Stop Relocated

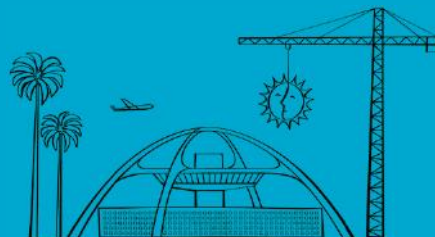
- Effective Wednesday, December 18 at 6:00AM, the Hotel & Private Parking shuttle stop at Terminal 2 (Departures Level) will be relocated approximately 500’ west
- Shuttle stop zones are identified by red pylon signage and painted curbs

## 5. Construction Milestone: Intermodal Transportation Facility (ITF) – West

- The first foundation pour for ITF-West, a parking facility along the future Automated People Mover route, has been completed
- ITF-West will provide 4,300 parking spaces when it opens in 2021
