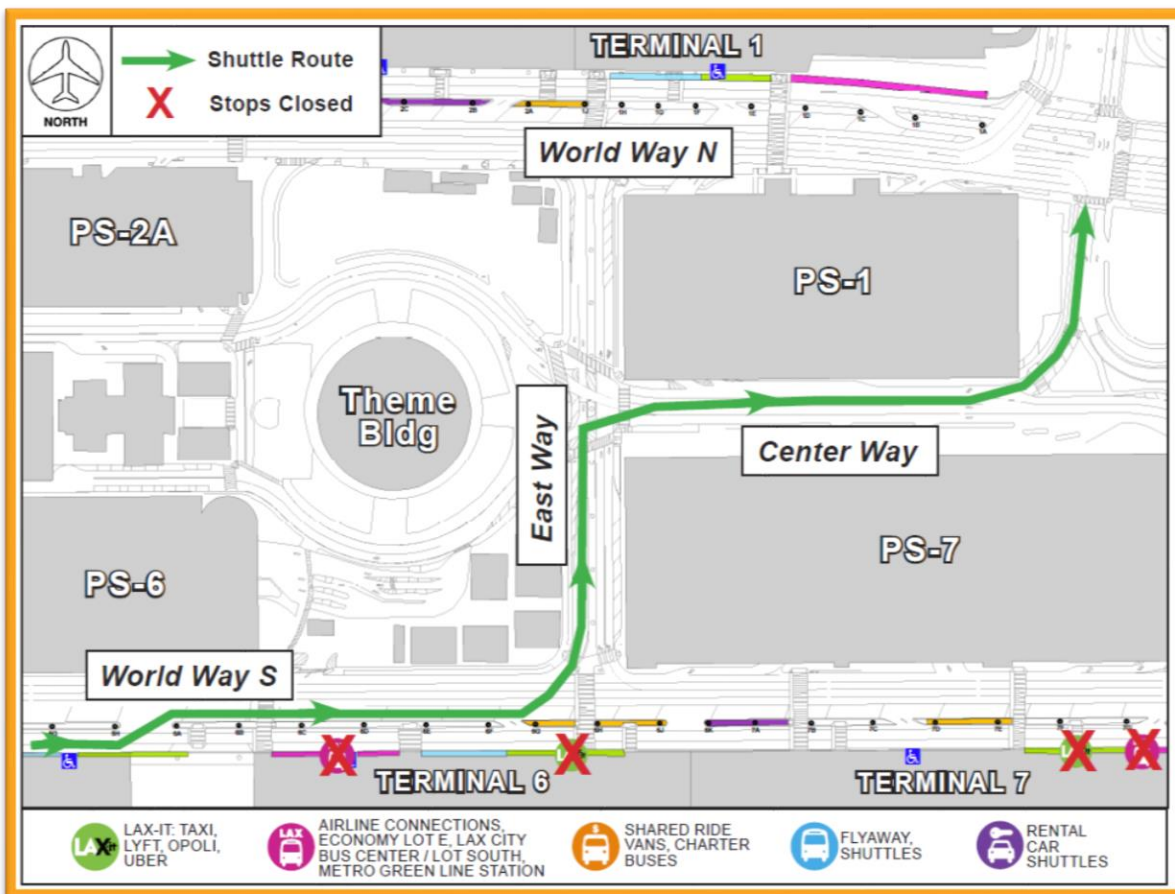
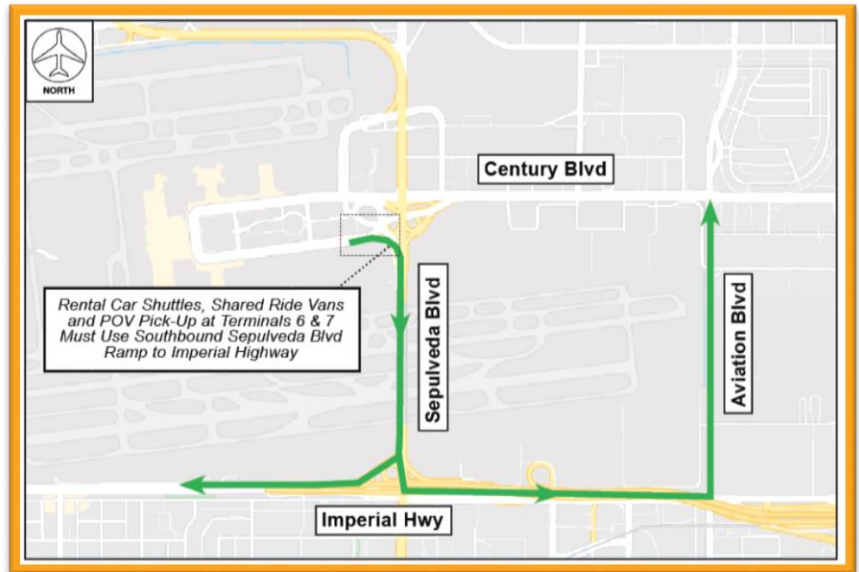

1. Terminal 6 & 7: Shuttle Operation Impacts

- To facilitate guideway work for the Automated People Mover project, inner lane LAWA Shuttle stops at Terminals 6 and 7 will be closed nightly from 1 AM to 7AM tonight and tomorrow night, Monday, July 19 and Tuesday, July 20
- Guests are directed to stops at Terminal 5 and shuttles are detoured to Center Way
- Outer lane shuttles and POV pick-up will be maintained at Terminals 6 and 7 but are detoured to southbound Sepulveda Boulevard

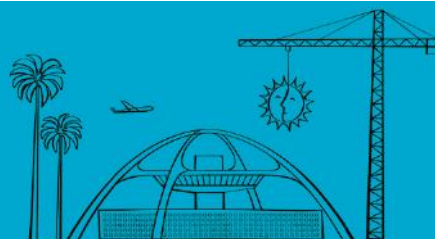


Top: Detour route for POV's and Outer Lane Shuttles

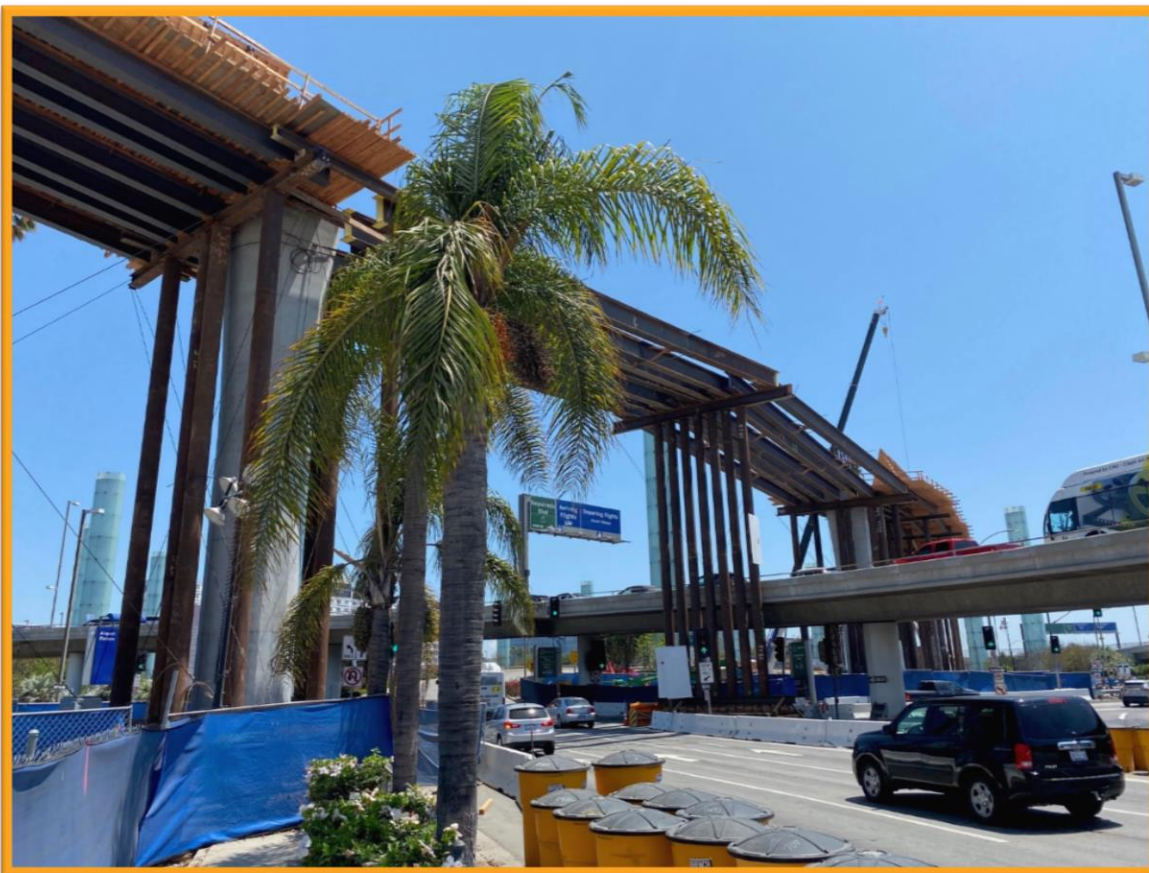
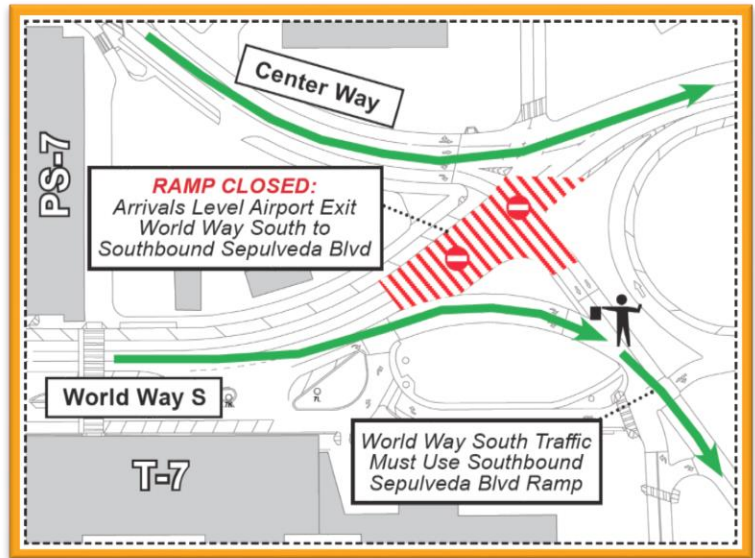

2. Lane Closures: APM Guideway at World Way South

- The Automated People Mover project is installing falsework over World Way South to complete a portion of the elevated guideway
- As detailed on Page 1, nightly closures will be in place the first half of the week to facilitate this work

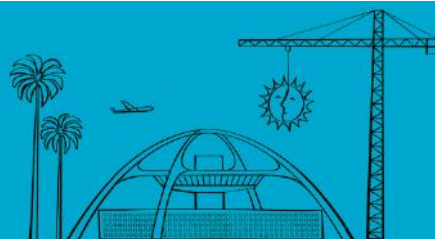


Top: Diagram of nightly road closures for APM guideway installation

3. LAMP Milestone: Consolidated Rent-A-Car Facility

- The ConRAC Project, one component of the Landside Access Modernization Program, celebrated a major milestone with its final concrete pour and official “topping off”
- The project broke ground in 2019 and is scheduled to open in 2023; when it does, it will be the largest consolidated rent-a-car facility in the world
- When the Automated People Mover is complete, the train will connect the ConRAC facility to LAX, removing the need for rental car shuttles
