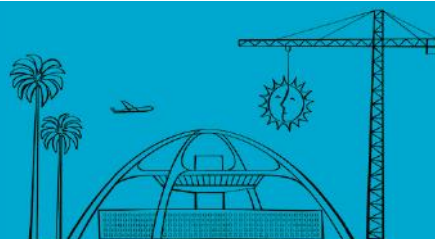
## 1. Updates to Arrivals Level Ground Transportation

- In Construction Hot Topics issued February 14, 2022, changes to Ground Transportation stops at and around Terminal 4 were reported due to the start of American Airlines' Terminal 4 Headhouse Modernization program
- While some of these newly located stops have worked well, others have not been able to serve guests as planned; for this reason certain Ground Transportation stop locations have changed again, effective Friday, February 25, 2022

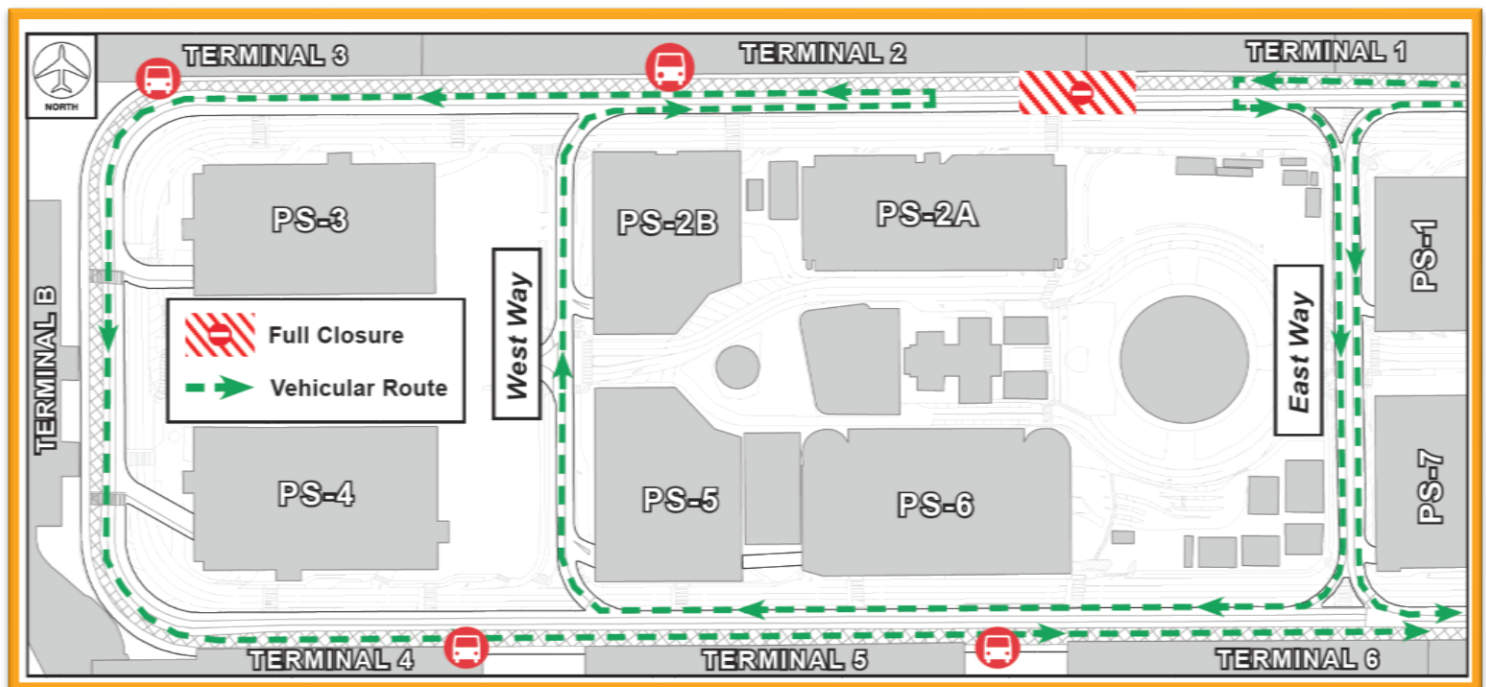

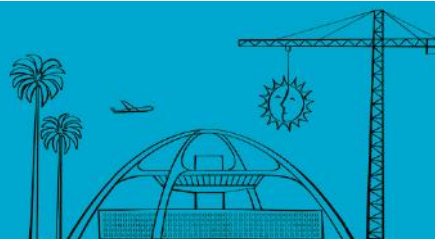
## 2. Automated People Mover: Terminal 1.5 Pedestrian Bridge

- Construction of a Pedestrian Bridge to connect Terminal 1.5 to the APM's Center CTA Station continues this week
- Full closures of Departures Level roadways at Terminal 1.5 are scheduled this week through Friday, March 4 between 12AM and 4AM; during full closures, traffic will be detoured per the map below
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, will be utilized to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction

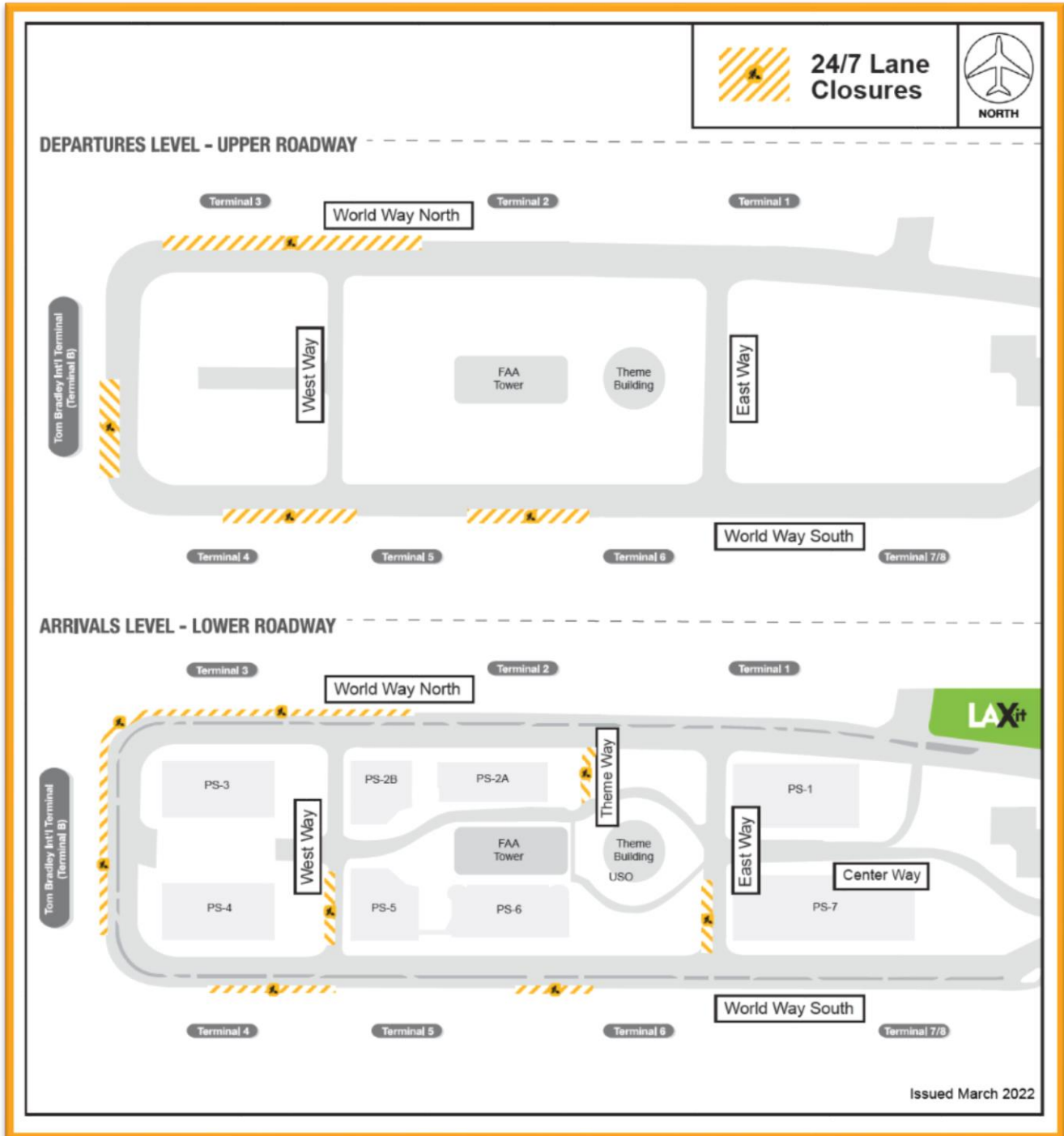
