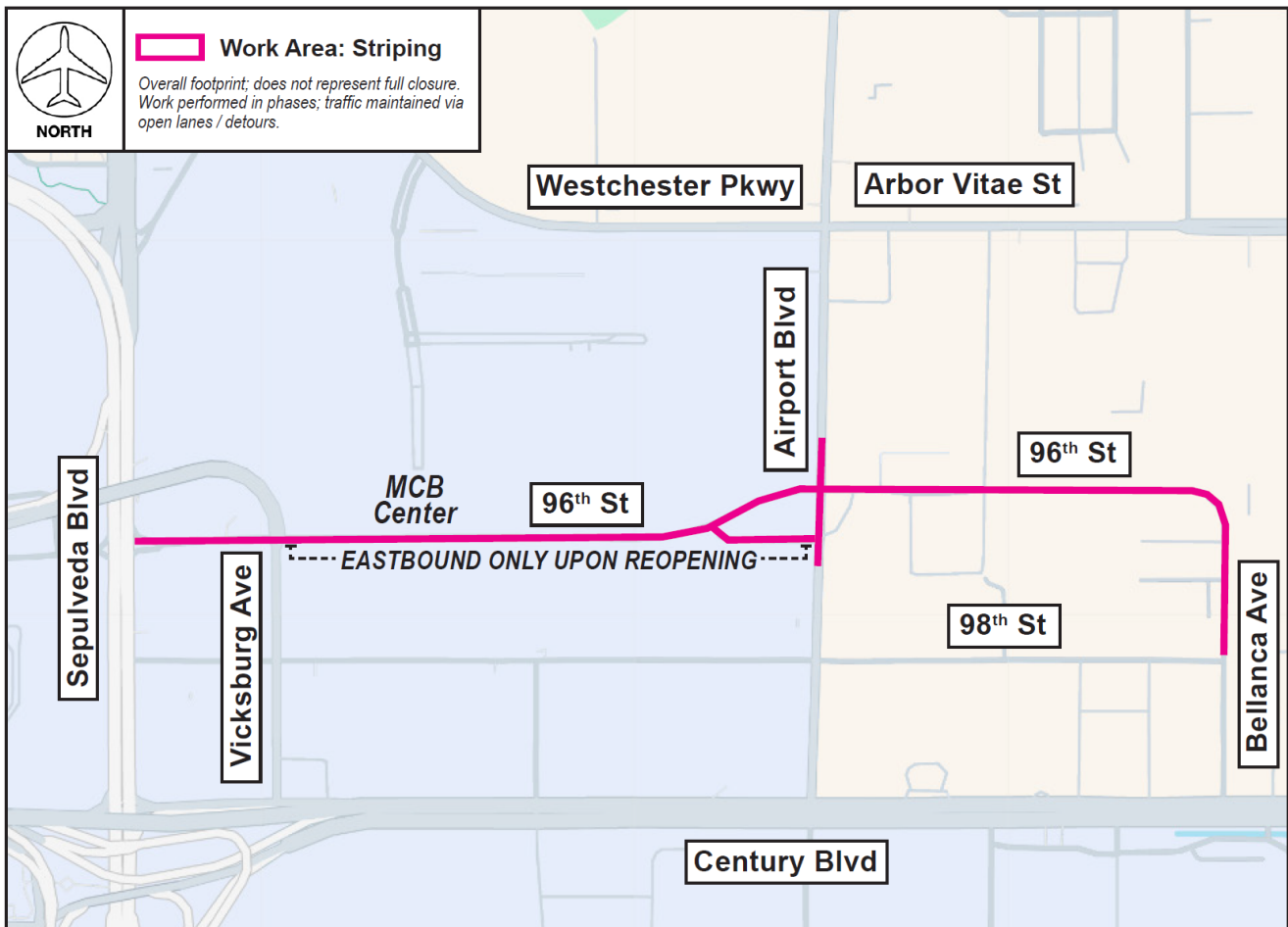


CONSTRUCTION HOT TOPICS

#1 LANE RESTRICTIONS: ROADWAY STRIPING ALONG 96TH ST

To facilitate roadway striping by the APM Project, 96th St between Sepulveda Blvd and Bellanca Ave will experience phased lane restrictions through tonight (Mon. 10/7) at 11PM. Traffic is maintained via open lanes or, when necessary, detours. When detours are needed, flaggers and signage will be in place.



PLEASE NOTE

Upon completion of striping installation, 96th St will reopen for traffic; the portion of 96th St between Vicksburg Ave and Airport Blvd will be eastbound only.

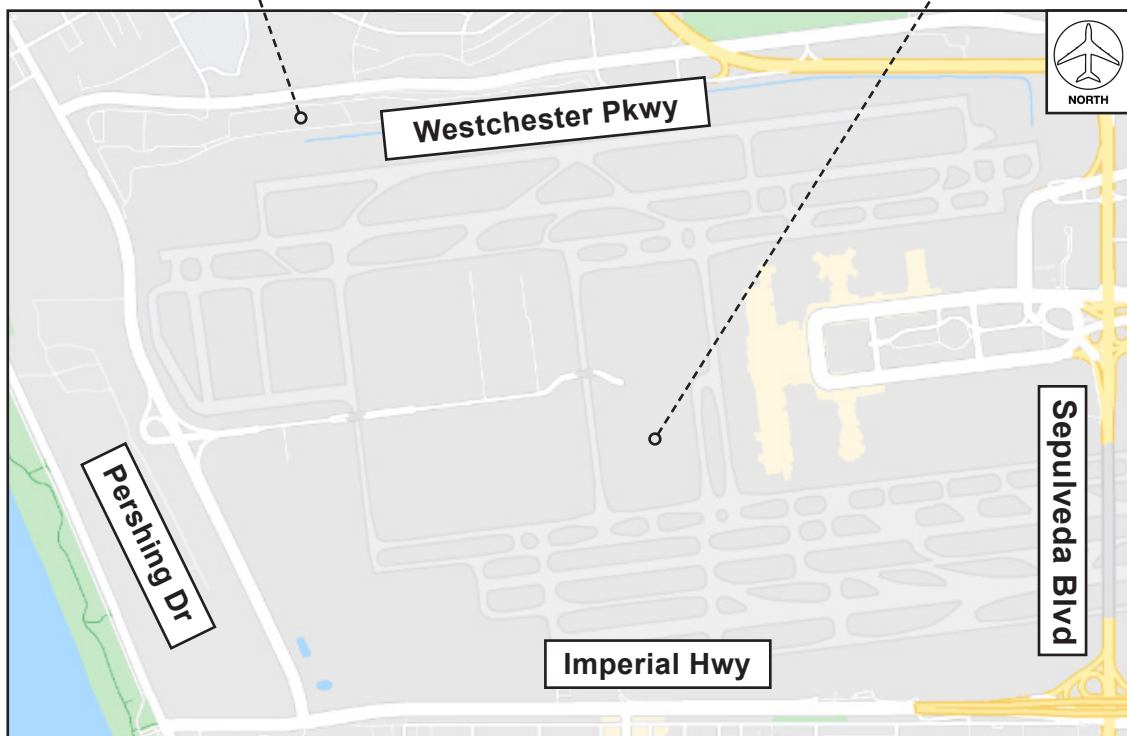
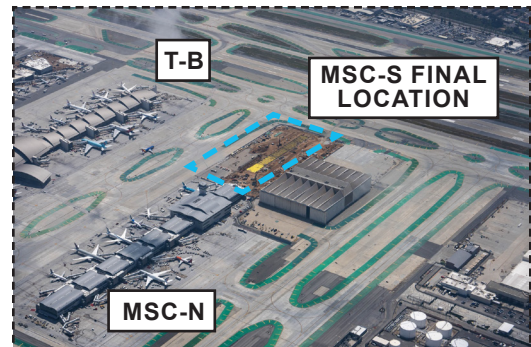

PLEASE NOTE:

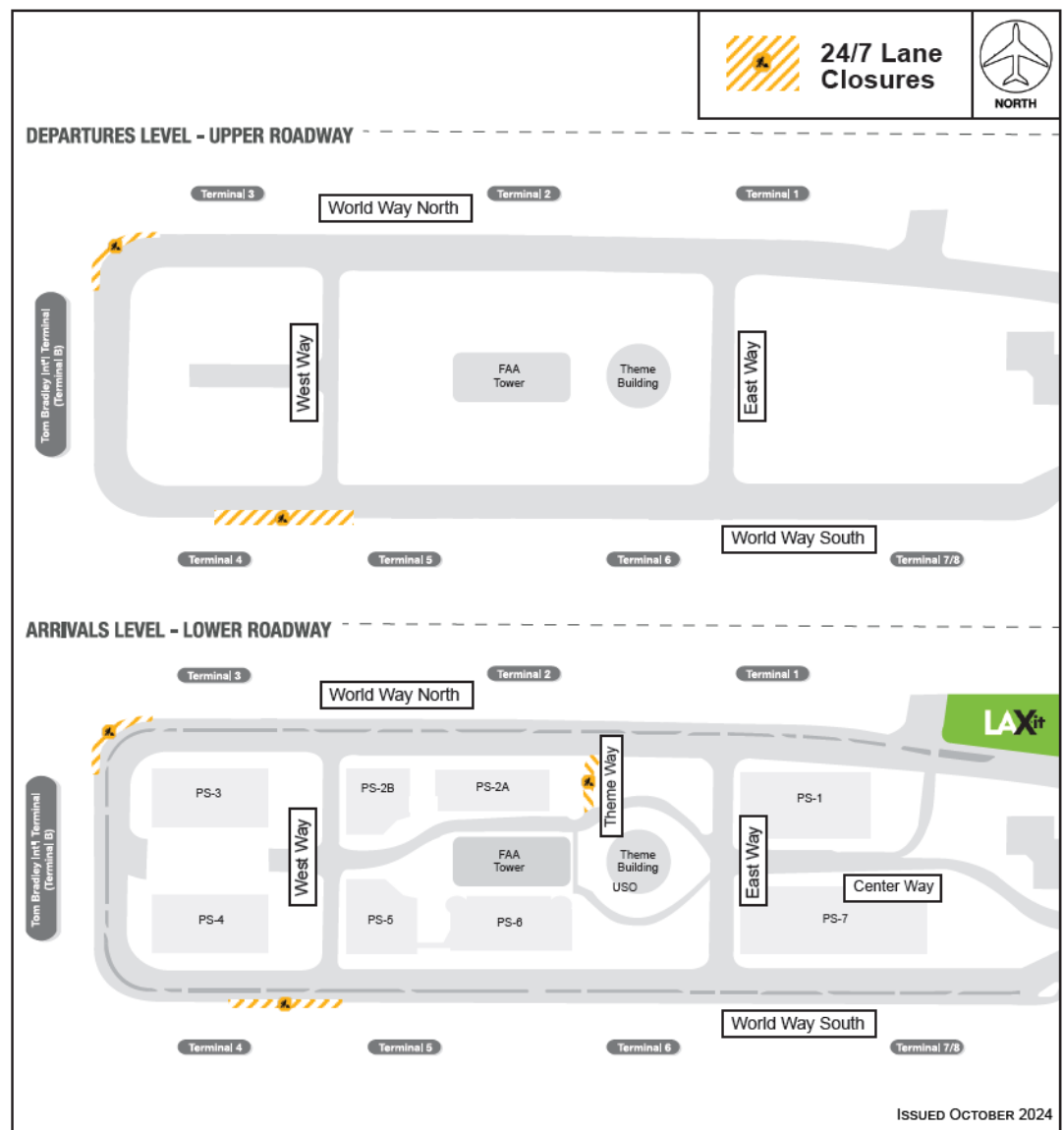
This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.
