



TERMINAL 4: PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE DEMOLITION

This edition of Construction Hot Topics will focus on the upcoming impacts related to the APM Project's demolition and removal of the pedestrian bridge between Terminal 4 and Parking Structure 4. See sheets 2 & 3 for additional information about Ground Transportation imapcts during this operation.



Demolition and removal of the bridge is scheduled for Saturday, October 19 and Sunday, October 20. Work to remove the bridge will occur between 2AM and 4:30AM both days.

During this time, two momentary holds of traffic (~20 mins each) will occur on the Arrivals Level west of work area at the "South Knuckle" with traffic detoured to Inner Lanes at Column B9.

On the Departures Level, vehicles accessing Terminals 3, B & 4 will use Parking Structure 4 to exit via Arrivals (over-height vehicles higher than 7' 6" & Hotel Shuttles must use Upper West Way).







TERMINAL 4: PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE DEMOLITION RENTAL CAR SHUTTLE STOP IMPACTS

To facilitate the Pedestrian Bridge demolition and removal, the Terminal 4 Rental Car Shuttle Stop at Columns 4E - 4F will be relocated east to Columns 5A - 5B beginning Wednesday, October 16 at 6AM continuous through Tuesday, October 22 at 6AM.

Signage will be in place alerting guests about the relocated stop. Please watch for posted signage, use caution when traveling near construction areas, and plan ahead for potential delays.











TERMINAL 4: PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE DEMOLITION HOTEL SHUTTLE STOP IMPACTS

To facilitate the Pedestrian Bridge demolition and removal, Hotel Shuttle Stops at Terminal 3 and Terminal B (Departures Level) will be closed Saturday, October 19 and Sunday, October 20, both days from 12AM to 4:30AM.

Hotel Shuttles (and any over-height vehicles above 7' 6") must use Upper West Way. Note: Upper East Way will also be available.

Signage will be in place alerting guests about the closed stops and alternate options. Please watch for posted signage, use caution when traveling near construction areas, and plan ahead for potential delays.









#4 OCTOBER 2024: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

The map below is a collective snapshot of all scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of October 2024.

PLEASE NOTE:

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA: other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

ACCESS MAINTAINED:

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off.

PLAN AHEAD:

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays.
