TERMINAL 4 IMPACTS

To facilitate construction for the American Airlines Terminal 4/5 Modernization Program, the following impacts are active in Terminal 4:

Central Concourse Closed: Phase 2 of construction requires barricades to shutdown the middle portion of Terminal 4 through 2027. Guests are being directed to use the Arrivals Tunnel on Level 1 to reach the South Concourse and open Airline Gates / facilities.

With the closure of the Central Concourse, Airline Gates 42B, 45 & 46A are closed / non-operational through April 20, 2027. Interior holdrooms at these gates are not available due to the closure.

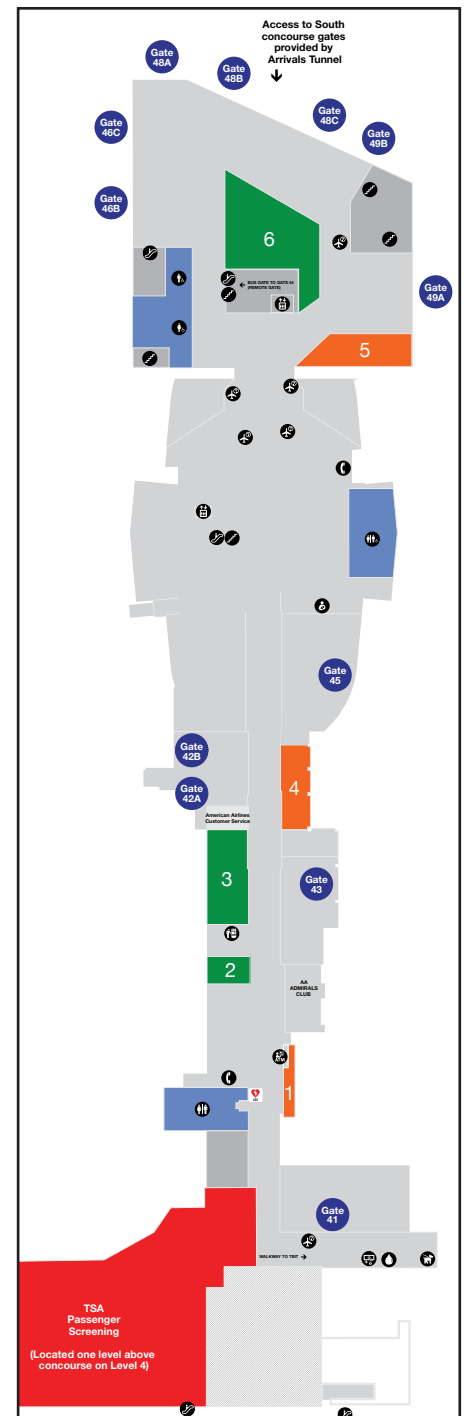
Next month, the following Airline Gate impacts are scheduled to occur in Terminal 4:

Gate 43: Closed February 10 through August 29, 2025

Gates 47A & 47B: Reopen April 15, 2025; closed since October 3, 2024

Curbside construction barricades are also required on both the Arrivals and Departures Level as part of this project; vehicular and pedestrian traffic is maintained at all times.

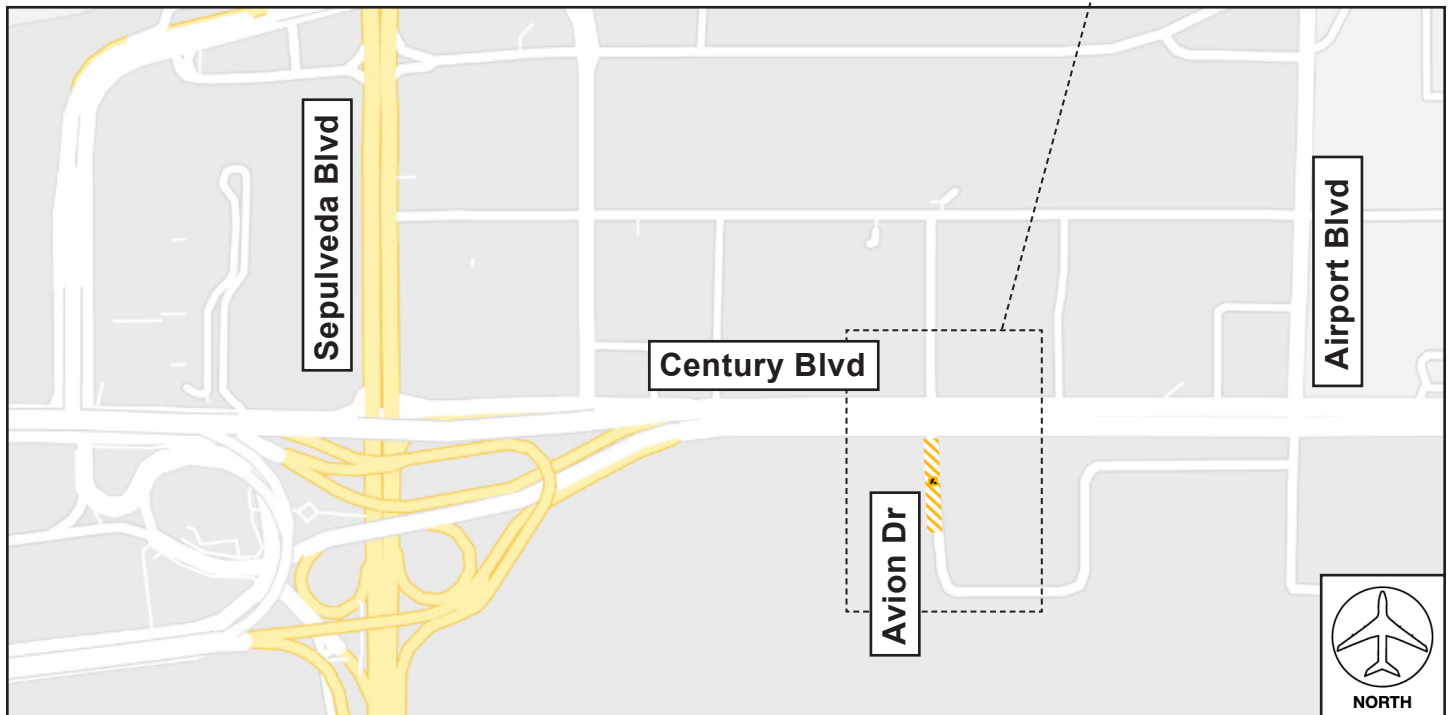

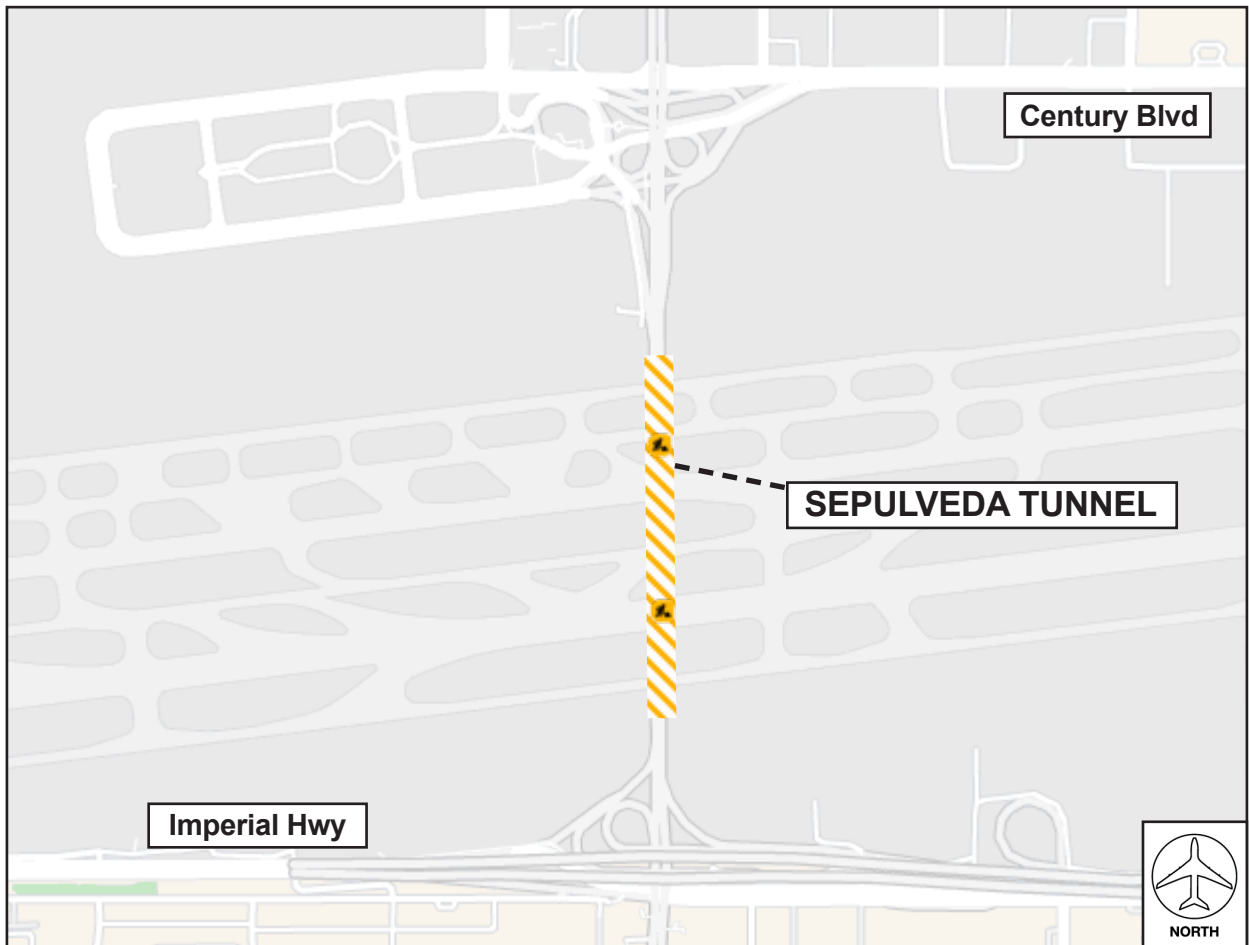

FEBRUARY 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

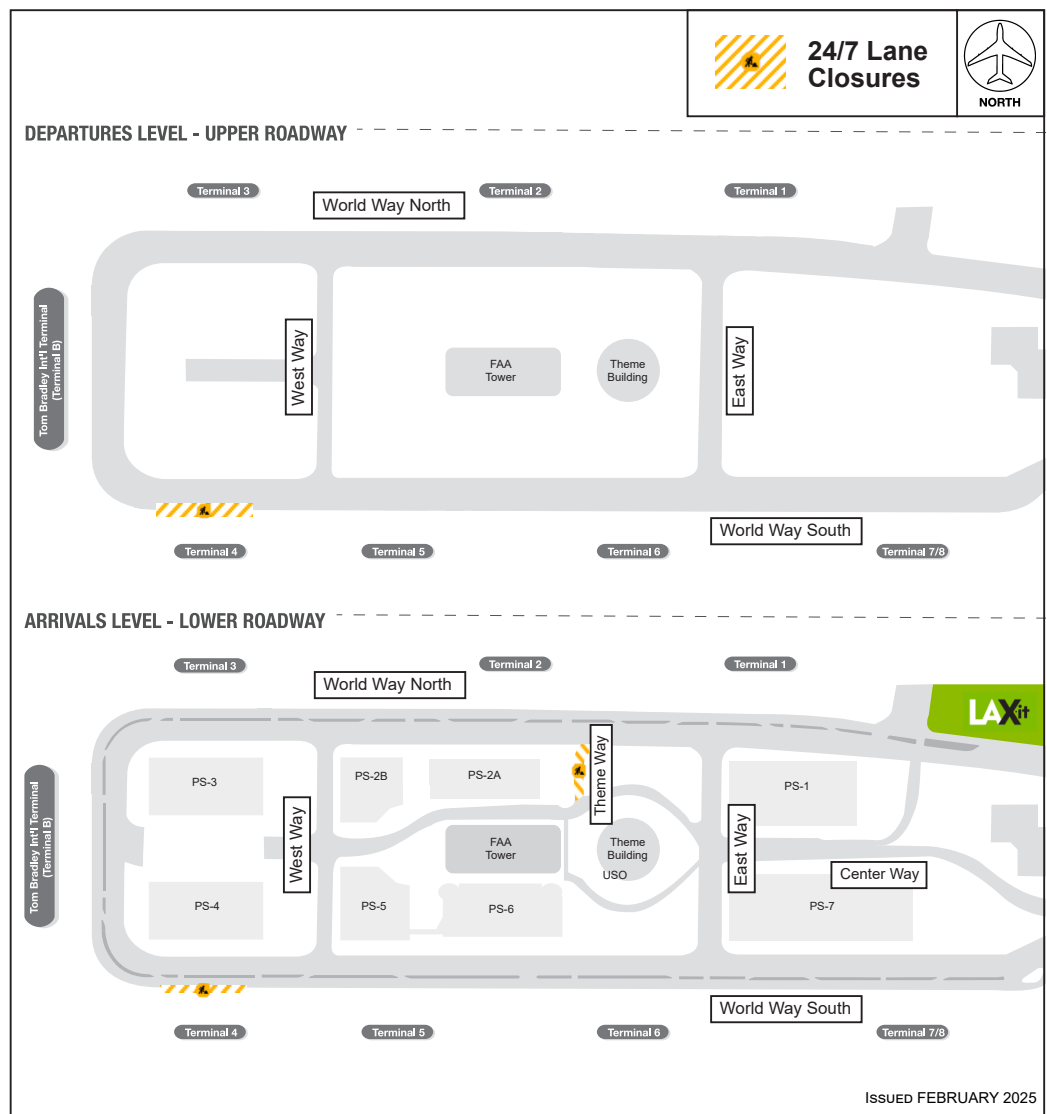
The map below is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of February 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
