TERMINAL 6: GATE 68B TO RE- OPEN THIS WEEK

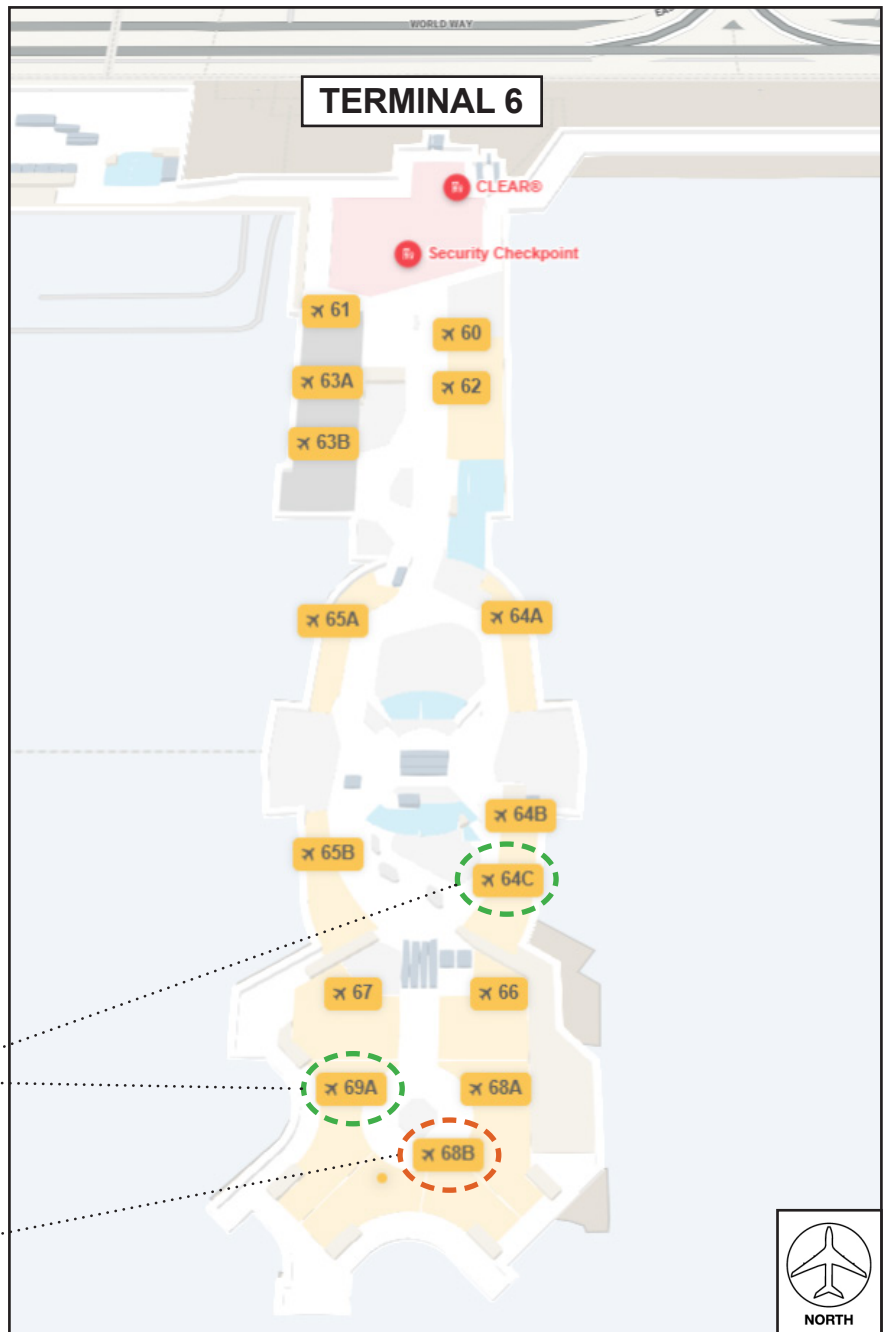
Be advised that Airline Gate 68B in Terminal 6 is closed continuously through March 28 to facilitate construction on the Air Operations Area (AOA).

During this closure, Alaska Airlines and Air Canada flights will be accommodated at Gate 69A, and United Airlines widebody flights will be accommodated at the Terminal B West Remote Gates using LAWA Buses from Gate 64C.

Interior holdrooms, seating and other amenities remain available to guests inside the Terminal at these areas.

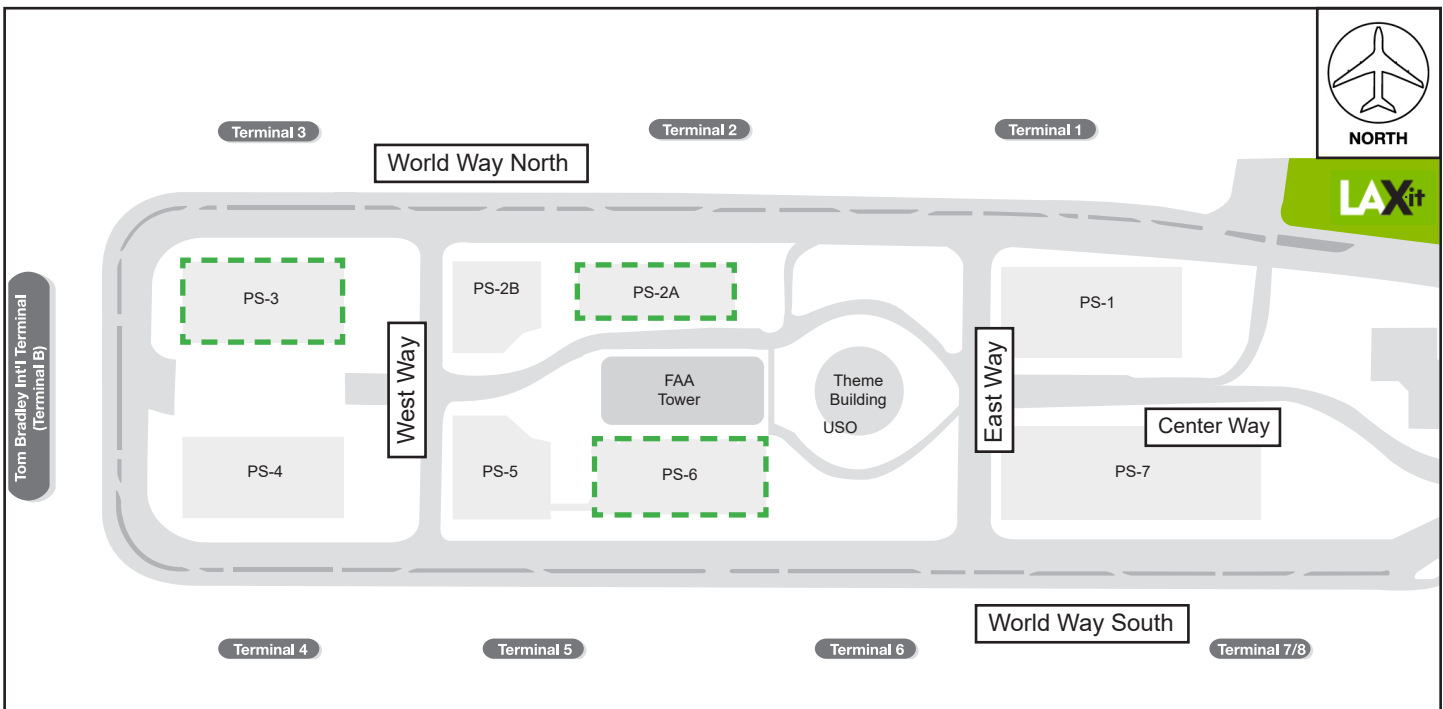

DISTRIBUTED ANTENNA SYSTEM INSTALLATION

Distributed Antenna System equipment installation in Parking Structures 2A, 3 and 6 is scheduled for completion this Friday, March 28.

A Distributed Antenna System (DAS) is a network of antennas that boosts wireless signals and enhances coverage and capacity by capturing, amplifying, and distributing signals for smooth connectivity.

DAS equipment installation remains ongoing at other areas, with work scheduled to be complete per the following schedule: Parking Structure 7 - April 30; Parking Structure 4 - May 21; and Terminal 6 Curbside - May 31.

MARCH 2025: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

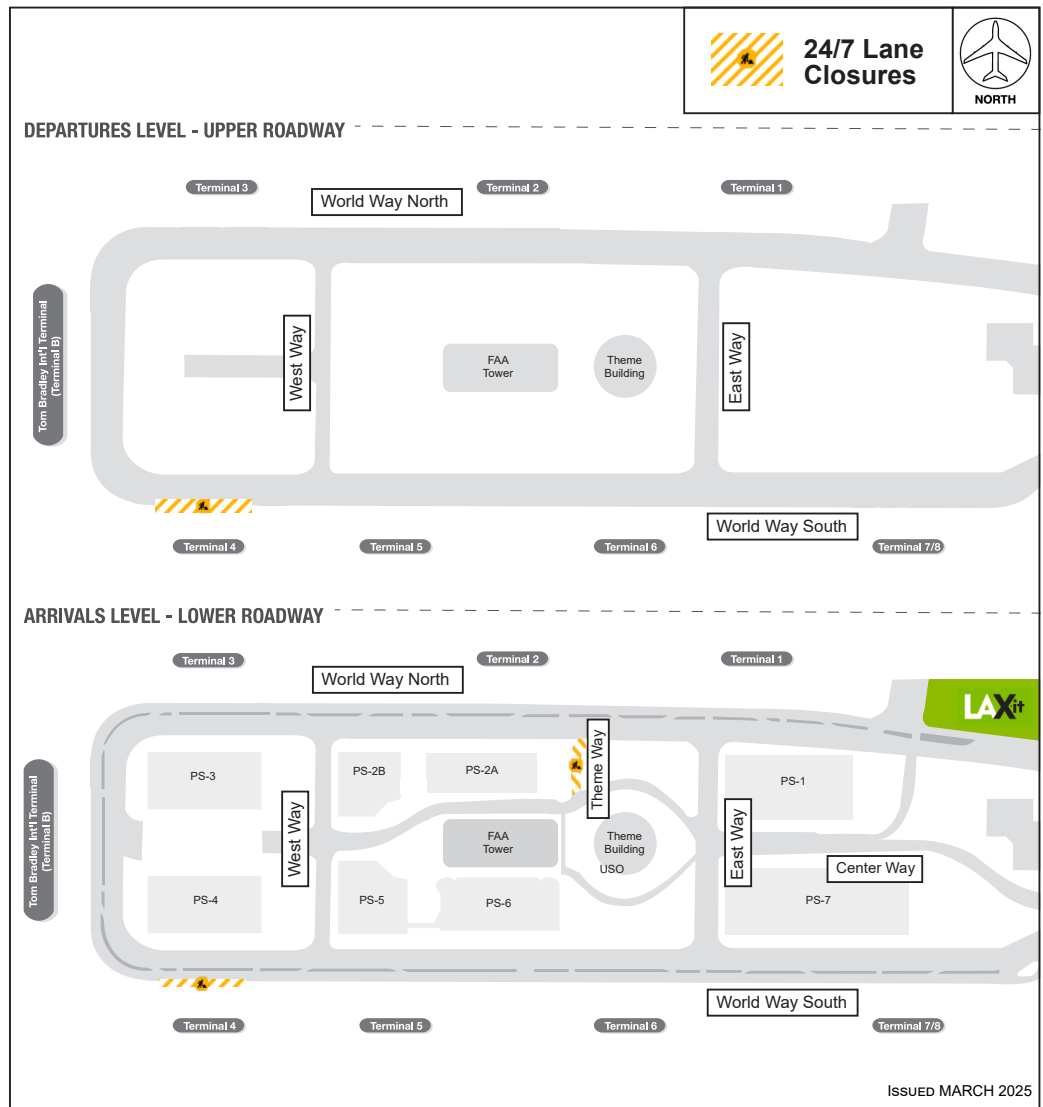
Here is a collective snapshot of scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of March 2025.

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; nightly lane / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off and ingress to / egress from parking structures.

Motorists should plan ahead for potential delays and use caution when traveling near construction areas.
