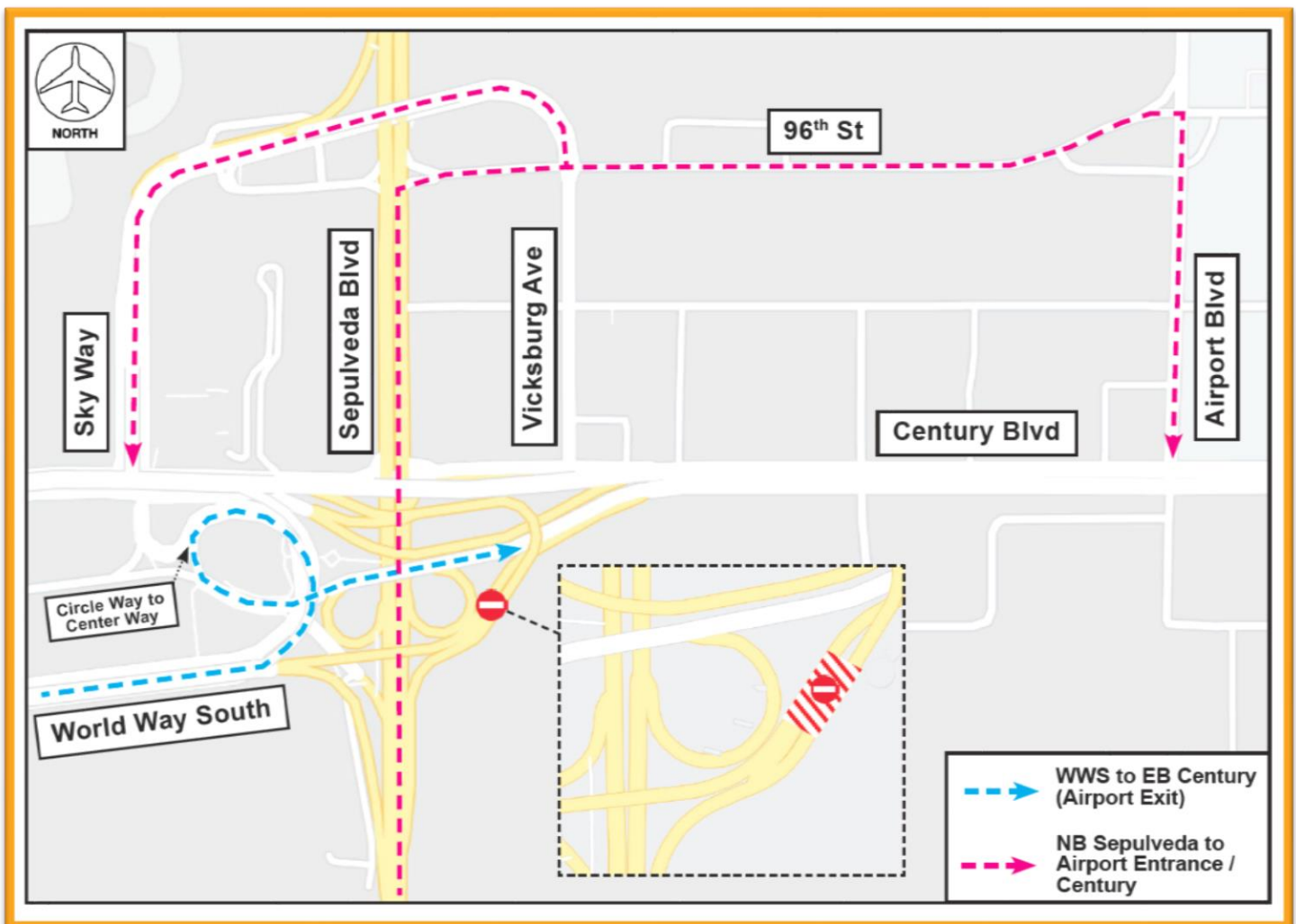


Construction Hot Topics

Week of August 2, 2021

1. Nightly Impacts to Airport Exit / Entrance

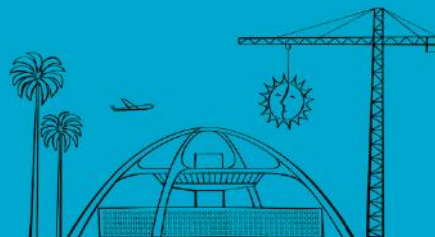
- The Automated People Mover project will begin work to install a portion of the elevated guideway across the eastbound Century Boulevard ramp just east of the East Sepulveda Loop
- Nightly lane closures will be needed between midnight at 4AM to facilitate this work beginning Thursday, August 5 through Saturday, August 21, Tuesdays through Sundays only
- Vehicles exiting the airport from Departures Level World Way South will be detoured to Circle Way down to the Arrivals Level and use Center Way to exit the airport
- Vehicles travelling northbound on Sepulveda Boulevard will continue north and use eastbound 96th Street to (1) northbound Vicksburg Avenue to enter the Airport via Skyway Boulevard OR (2) southbound on Airport Boulevard to reach Century Boulevard

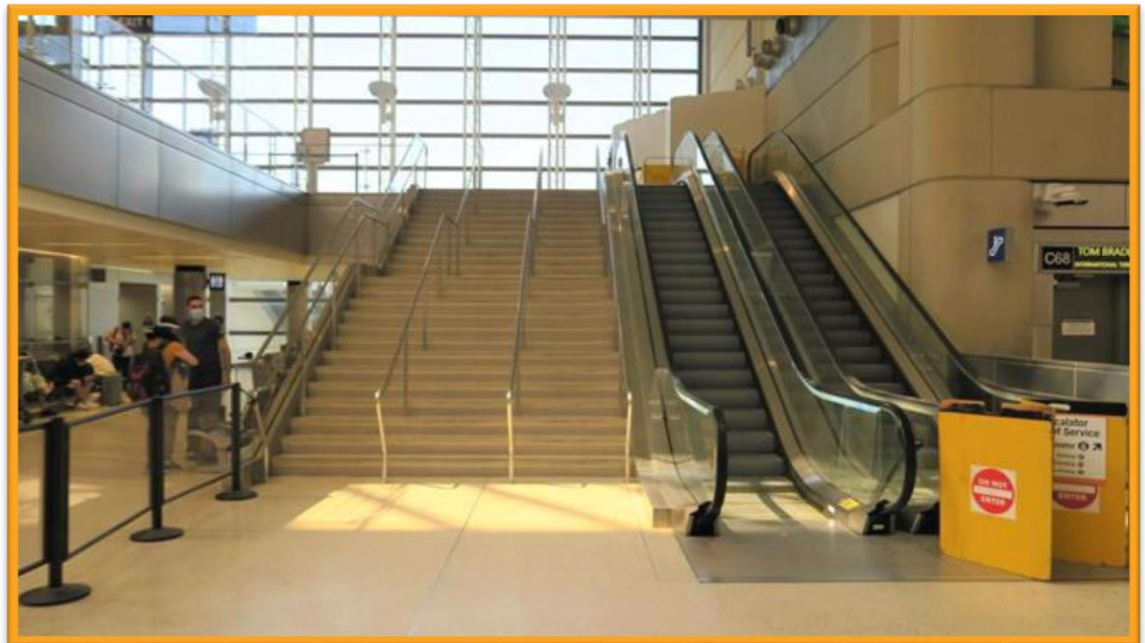

2. Terminal B: Construction Progress

- Construction of the new Vertical Core at Terminal B is making progress with the installation of glass panels at terminal's north end, as seen below
- Due to this portion of construction, the escalators and stairs at the north end of the terminal are closed; signage is in place directing guests to the south escalators
- Due to construction on the north mezzanine, guests are routed to the south mezzanine for TSA Screening access



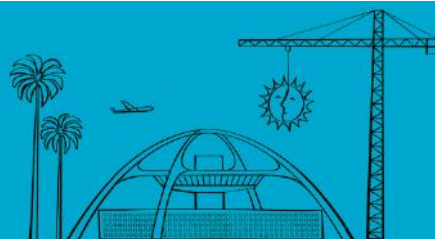
Glass installation progress at Terminal B's north end

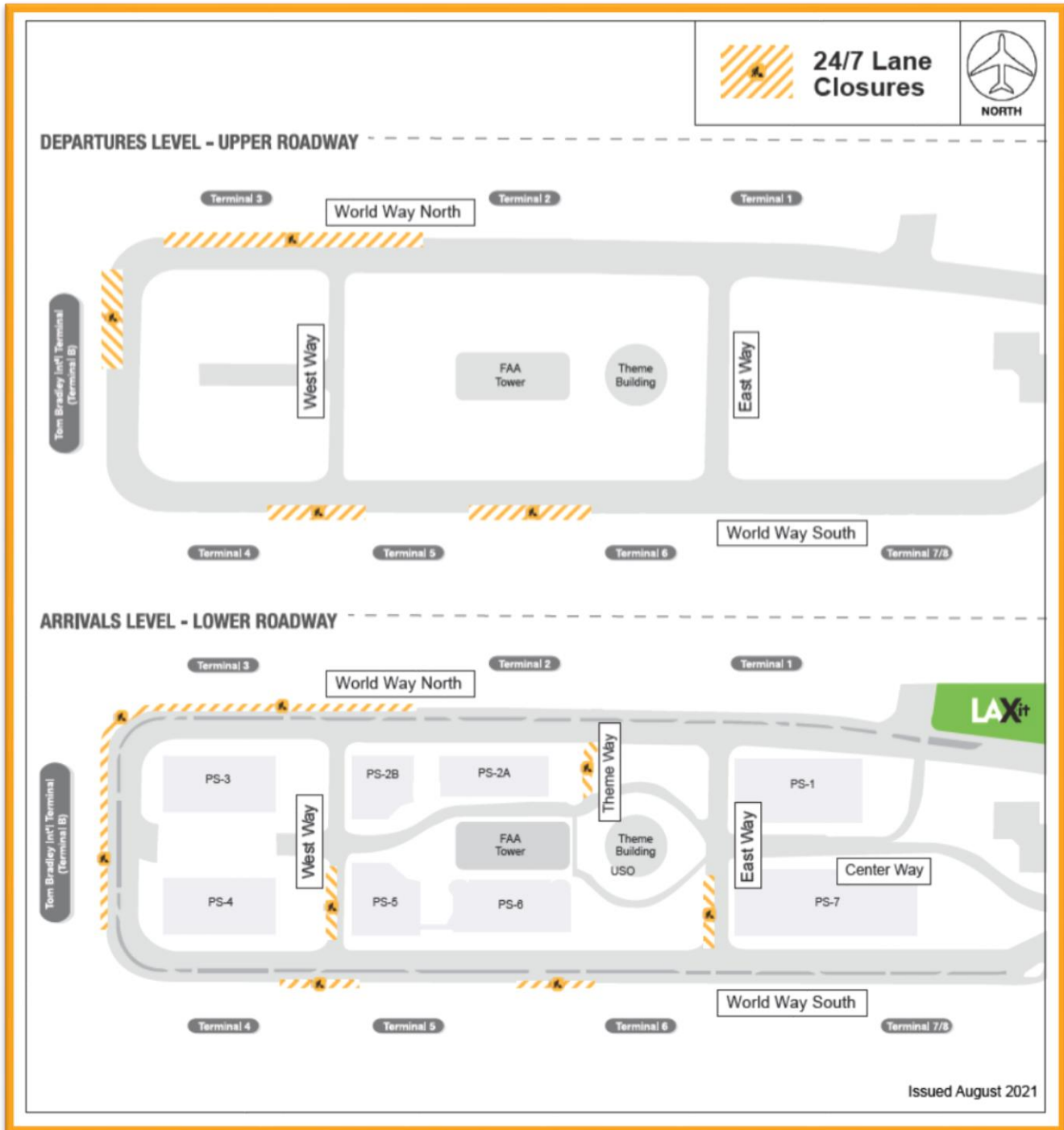
