Overlap of Public Hearings with Roundtable Meeting Nights

Dear Ms. Lindsey:

The LAX-Community Noise Roundtable was established about eight years ago to bring elected officials at all levels representing communities surrounding LAX, FAA representatives, the airlines, and local community groups together with LAWA to find win-win solutions to issues that reduce the noise impacts caused by LAX aircraft operations. In order to accommodate so many officials with very diverse, active schedules we have consistently maintained our scheduled meetings on the second Wednesday of each month (except for the months of August and December) at 7:00 P.M.

We have observed that several of the recent public meetings and workshops conducted by LAWA to acquaint us and the public with various aspects of the evolving LAX Master Plan and LAX operational issues overlap the Roundtable's meeting time. We assume that the conflicting dates are the result of an oversight and request that LAWA to strategically plan future meetings so that they are not in conflict with the Roundtable meetings to ensure that we can actively participate in all public meetings.
