LAX Fly Quieter Program Overview

A public education and recognition program designed to:

- Increase Operator/pilot awareness of community noise concerns and adherence with noise abatement operating procedures and restrictions at LAX
- Encourage and acknowledge commercial operators for operating as quietly as possible
- Score and rank all Operators on their performance and publicly acknowledge those that perform the best

Fly Quieter Program Scoring Elements



5 Primary Elements

1. **Quietest Arrivals:** based on measured noise levels from 2 monitors in residential communities
2. **Quietest Fleet:** based on certificated noise levels of aircraft operating at LAX
3. **Pilot-Initiated Early Turns:** based on the number of pilot-initiated early turns flying over communities
4. **Nighttime Non-Conforming East Departures:** based on the number of non-conforming east departures during 12 AM and 6:30 AM
5. **Restricted Nighttime Engine Run-Ups:** based on compliance with the maintenance engine run-up restrictions between 11 pm and 6 am

2 Bonus Elements

1. **Operator Noise Reduction Efforts:** implementing any equipment, technology, or procedural type effort to reduce aircraft noise
2. **Stakeholder Engagement Efforts:** implementing outreach and educational efforts with various stakeholders



