1. LAX^{it}Scheduled to Open End of October

- At the end of October 2019, LAXit is scheduled to open, providing a centralized area for passengers to get picked up by Taxi or a Ride App Pickup
- Passengers may walk or take a dedicated shuttle to the lot, located east of Terminal 1 (see map, right)
- Passenger drop off by Taxis and Ride App Pickup will still be allowed curbside on the Departures Level at each terminal

- Bag Claim Device #2 and #3 will be closed for the duration of this phase of the project; other nearby Claim Devices will remain available for passenger use







4. [UPDATE] CTA Arrivals Level: Curb Extension
