


Construction Hot Topics

1. Terminal 3: Pedestrian Bridge Demolition

- The pedestrian bridge between Terminal 3 & Parking Structure 3 is scheduled to be demolished November 11 - 12, 2020 as part of the Automated People Mover project; soft demolition work is scheduled to begin this week
- During a phase of soft demolition, the Departures Level sidewalk at Terminal 3 will be closed (October 29 through November 3); temporary wayfinding will be in place to direct guests to the Arrivals Level





2. Terminal 2 / 3: Construction Update


- Construction of the future Terminal 2 / 3 Head House continues as part of the Delta Sky Way Program with noticeable progress on the building's framework, pictured below from Terminal 2 (airside)
- Upon completion, the Head House will facilitate ticketing, check-in, security screening and bag claim for both terminals and also connect to the pedestrian walkway bridge from the Automated People Mover's Center CTA Station



3. Terminal 5: Airline Gate 53A Closed

- Airline Gate 53A in Terminal 5 is scheduled to be closed October 26, 2020 through January 15, 2021 as part of the American Airlines Terminal 5 Gate Realignment project
- Inside the concourse, the Gate 53A hold room area will remain available for guest seating
