

1. Terminal 2: Pedestrian Bridge Demolition

- To facilitate construction for the Automated People Mover (APM) project, the Pedestrian Bridge connecting Terminal 2 and Parking Structure 2A will be demolished this week over two nights: Thursday, January 28 into Friday, January 29 and Friday, January 29 into Saturday, January 30
- All Arrivals and Departures Level roadway lanes and sidewalks at Terminal 2 will be closed from 12AM to 4AM both nights during demolition
- Signage and detours will be in place for employee parking access, vehicular and pedestrian routes, and shuttle operations on both levels




Pedestrian Bridge between Terminal 2 and Parking Structure 2A, pictured from the Departures Level roadway looking east



2. Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Cleaning


- The Sepulveda Tunnel will experience nightly (11pm – 5am) lane restrictions this week for cleaning by the City of Los Angeles Bureau of Street Services
- Two lanes on either northbound or southbound Sepulveda Boulevard will be closed per night, with one lane maintained at all times



Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Cleaning by BSS










3. EXTENDED; Overnight Ramp Closures: APM Construction

- Overnight closures of the northbound or southbound ramps at the entrance / exit to LAX (Century Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard) are needed through January 29, 2021 to facilitate construction of the Automated People Mover guideway over Sepulveda Boulevard
- Only one ramp will be closed at a time; detours and temporary signage will be in place
