
1. Terminal 5.5: Construction Progress

- The Terminal 5.5 Core project is making progress on exterior finishes including trim and side paneling as seen in the before & after pictures below from November 2021 and March 2022
- Four months has made quite the difference for the building that will provide enhanced connectivity between Terminals 5 and 6 as well to the Automated People Mover; construction of that Pedestrian Bridge between Terminal 5.5 and the APM's Center CTA Station is scheduled to begin April 2022 and will be the fifth out of six total Pedestrian Bridges in the CTA to be constructed
- As construction of the Terminal 5.5 Core continues, drop-off and pick-up lanes on the Arrivals and Departures Levels are being used as temporary pedestrian walkways, pictured below; traffic is maintained at all times


2. Terminal 4: Operations for Modernization Program

- Due to the Terminal 4 Modernization Program, terminal operations are conducted in the west half of the headhouse while the east half undergoes demolition and, eventually, construction of a portion of the new terminal
- On the Arrivals Level, bag claim is now located in the former Customs area in the west end of the terminal; on the Departures Level, many ticketing / check-in desks have been relocated to the western portion of the lobby

Terminal 4 operations will occur in the west half of the headhouse as construction is ongoing in the east half






3. Automated People Mover: Guideway Construction

- Construction of the APM guideway over Sepulveda Boulevard is making great progress and is scheduled to be complete by next month
- Pictured right: During nightly construction, up to two lanes on Sepulveda Boulevard near LAX will be restricted with at least one lane in both directions maintained (nightly lane restrictions Monday through Saturday only between 12AM and 6AM)
- Pictured below: Construction of the guideway is happening from both the east and west sides of Sepulveda Boulevard and will connect in the middle by next month!

4. Airline Gate Impacts: Recent & Upcoming Changes

- In Terminal 4, Airline Gates 43 & 45, both of which closed on November 29, 2021, re-opened last week on March 10, 2022
- In Terminal 6, Airline Gate 68B, which closed almost one year ago on March 17, 2021, reopened this week on March 14, 2022
- In Terminal B, Airline Gate 151, which closed on July 19, 2021, is scheduled to re-open this month on March 25, 2022
