

### DATE EXTENSION: **NB AVIATION BLVD** LANE CLOSURES

TO FACILITATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR THE APM PROJECT, NORTHBOUND AVIATION BLVD BETWEEN ARBOR VITAE ST AND CENTURY BLVD IS CLOSED CONTINUOUSLY THROUGH JUNE 2024 (EXTENDED FROM MARCH 2024).



#### PLEASE NOTE:

Traffic is detoured via WB Century Blvd, NB Airport Blvd and EB Arbor Vitae St. Detour signage remains in place with flaggers on site to assist with wayfinding and the maintenance of traffic. SB Aviation Blvd traffic is maintained at all times.












### #2 **EASTBOUND LANE CLOSURE ON ARBOR** VITAE STREET
